| Jonah Integrated Resource Management and Mitigation Program: Data Gap Evaluation and Recommendations | North Wind, Inc. | \$96,750 | Development of GIS based strategy for assessing cumulative effects on Anticline and Jonah. Development of a comprehensive database and incorporation of all relevant GIS info from various entities. | Disapproved - 1) redundant to current effort fully funded by BP and 2) not mitigation | \$0 |
| Double Bar E Ranch | Green River Valley Land Trust | \$1,000,000 | Conservation easement for maintaining open space and agricultural values with associated wildlife benefits. | Deferred to next cycle - need more info on mineral rights, potential to maintain some habitat types | \$0 |

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| New Water Developments for Livestock and Wildlife (Guzzlers) | Aster Canyon Consulting, LLC | \$60,830 | Purchase and placement of 3 wildlife guzzlers. | Disapproved - redundant to other water development projects | \$0 |
| Agriculture and Wildlife Management Planning Project | Wildlife Mgmt Services of the Rockies, LLC & Rimfire Ranch | \$129,651 | Includes baseline data collection on wildlife and habitat, design of projects & adaptive management strategies for achieving both agriculture & wildlife management goals. | Disapproved - excellent project, but not specific mitigation for Jonah impacts | \$0 |
| Wind Water | Ronald D. Gordon | \$100,000 | Planning & Design for numerous water wells for both irrigation and watering of livestock and wildlife. Would potentially include drilling of 50 wells initially and up to 30 wells per year after that. | Disapproved - 1) needs more analysis to determine exact locations/partners and 2) somewhat redundant to other water projects | \$0 |
| Bridger-Teton National Forest Habitat Enhancement Block Prescribed Burns | RMEF & USFS | \$50,000 | Includes the prescribed burning of up to 10 burn units and 4000 acres to improve aspen stands for wildlife. | Disapproved - good project, but not specific mitigation for Jonah impacts | \$0 |
| Triple Peak Forage Reserve | Trout Unlimited & numerous partners | \$25,000 | Purchase of USFS AUM's from permittee and turning them back to USFS. Development of criteria for grass bank and future use/implementation. | Disapproved - good project, but not specific mitigation for Jonah impacts | \$0 |
| Analysis of Ecological Resources in the Jonah II Field and Surrounding Areas | KC Harvey, LLC | \$1,181,500 | Incorporating vegetation parameters into Habitat Suitability Models, assessment of vegetation quality and analysis, development of detailed maps of soils, vegetation, water, climate, wildlife, HIS's & ecosystem health. | Disapproved - is not specific mitigation for Jonah impacts | \$0 |
| Habitat Improvement Pilot Project | Encana & Wyo. Board of State Land Commissioners | \$868,685.25 | Treatment of 5 acre test plots using Lawson Aerator, snow fence construction to add moisture for increased reclamation success, test of weed control methods, and repair of dam on Juel Reservoir. | Partially approved with modifications - disapproved past work; approved future work with input from JIO, max contribution of \$499K | \$499,000 |

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| Maki Aspen Enhancement | USFS | \$95,000 | Improvement of health and vigor of aspen and adjacent vegetation in the Maki project area (approx 2200 acres). | Disapproved - good project, but not specific mitigation for Jonah impacts | \$0 |
| Alkali Creek Restoration | BLM - Pinedale Field Office | \$15,000 | Installation of low gradient control structure to stop upstream headcutting and maintain the integrity of meadow which provides benefits to sage grouse and other wildlife species. | Deferred to next cycle - excellent project, but need more information on total scope and cost of work | \$0 |
| Cumulative Opportunities Analysis for Wildlife/Fisheries | Greystone | \$257,400 | Development of plan to identify/prioritize a full range of wildlife mitigation opportunities | Disapproved - 1) redundant to current effort fully funded by BP and 2) not mitigation | \$0 |
| Air Quality Studies & Monitoring | Greystone; Weather Mod Inc.; National Center for Atmospheric Research | \$1,984,356 | | Disapproved - not specific mitigation for Jonah impacts | \$0 |
