

How to Apply for JIO/PAPO Funding

1. JIO/PAPO project applications may be submitted at any time during the year until October 31 for consideration for funding during the next calendar year.
 - Project applications (and all attachments) may be submitted by email to:

 - *Files larger than 3 MB cannot be accepted*
 - or as hard copy to:

 - Pinedale WY 82941
 - Receipt of applications will be verified within 5 business days.
 - Project applications received after October 31 will be considered for funding during the next application cycle
 - Applicants are encouraged to visit the JIO/PAPO website and review our strategic plans and mitigation goals to ensure that proposed projects fall within the appropriate parameters
 - Applicants are also encouraged to visit the Jonah Infill Drilling Project and the Pinedale Anticline Project Records of Decision found at:
http://www.blm.gov/wy/st/en/field_offices/Pinedale.html
2. On a monthly basis, project applications that have been received will be made available on the JIO/PAPO website
 - The public is encouraged to view the website and provide comments to the JIO/PAPO as applications become available. Comments will only be acknowledged as having been received.
 - A hard copy of the project applications will be available in the JIO/PAPO office for those that do not have web access.
3. Project applications received before October 31 will be available for public comments until November 30
4. The JIO/PAPO team will begin to rank applications on or about December 1
5. The project ranking recommendations will be made to the Board of Directors by March 1 for a minimum 30-day review prior to the next meeting
6. Applications will be voted on by the Board during the next Board meeting, probably in April.
7. All applicants will be notified after this meeting regarding the funding status of the proposals
