As outlined in the April 10, 2012 correspondence by Shane DeForest (Field Manager for the Pinedale Field Office), the PAPO has been working with the BLM on proposed adaptive management change to the Pinedale Anticline Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS) Record of Decision (ROD), and the Pinedale Anticline Project Area Monitoring for Reclamation Success plan (Monitoring Plan).

Public comments were accepted on the proposed changes for a two week time period that ended on April 25, 2012. The PAPO and the BLM have prepared a response to the comments and have made changes to the Monitoring Plan that is currently being used by operators for the 2012 field season.

The April 10, 2012 correspondence, the response to public comments, the revised Monitoring Plan (referred to as the "Final Draft Reclamation Plan – updated May 15, 2012") and related background information links are listed under the "Proposed Adaptive Management" section on the PAPO website.

Per the information in the April 10, 2012 correspondence, it is expected the Monitoring Plan will be finalized by April 1, 2013.
