Pinedale Anticline Project Office (PAPO) 2013 Project Funding Application Guidelines

Dear Potential PAPO Project Applicant:

Please read the following information and guidelines prior to submitting your application for potential 2013 funding.

Potential PAPO funding

Project applicants are required to use the 2013 PAPO application and applicants should refer to the 2013 Project Ranking Score Sheet to provide information to the applicant on PAPO strategic plan goals and 2013 PAPO priorities.

PAPO funding guidelines, deadline date and to obtain additional information

The PAPO strongly encourages the submittal of projects that relate to the PAPO's strategic plan goals and priorities. As an example, projects that were funded in 2012 related primarily to Pinedale Anticline wildlife mitigation projects that benefit mule deer, pronghorn and sage grouse through the construction of wildlife friendly fences, water development and planning funds for habitat improvement projects.

Because PAPO funding relates to the degree of drilling on the Anticline, funds available for potential PAPO projects have declined significantly. Therefore, the PAPO has placed increased emphasis on projects that meet PAPO strategic plan goals and 2013 PAPO priorities.

Applicants should also be advised that submittal of a project proposal has no guarantee of project funding. The PAPO Board of Directors makes all final decisions relating to project funding. The PAPO Board will likely make project funding decisions at the Board's May 2013 meeting.

The deadline for 2013 PAPO Project Applications is October 31, 2012 for all applicants (public, non-profit, state, federal, etc.) with the exception of the PAPO office that reserves the right to submit projects throughout the year due to the potential changing of priorities and other factors.
