| Square top windmill to solar conversion & Predatory Perch Reduction | \$43,100 | \$67,900 | This project would replace a windmill and convert it to solar and would provide year-round water for livestock and mule deer. Brood rearing sage grouse, pronghorn and other sagebrush species would all benefit. | This project is off site mitigation located just outside of the PAPO border approximately 20 miles south of Boulder on BLM lands |
| North Mesa Basin Reservoir Improvement and Habitat Enhancement | \$40,000 | \$50,000 | The purpose of this water well/reservoir improvement project is to provide year-round water for livestock and wildlife while improving habitat for sage grouse and mule deer on the North Mesa. | This project is on-site mitigation west of Pinedale located on the North Mesa inside Core Area |
| Mesa Fence modification project | \$261,000 | \$249,000 | This project would finish the wildlife friendly fence marking project on the Mesa and help minimize mortality of mule deer, pronghorn and Sage Grouse. | This project is on-site mitigation on the Mesa. |
| Fayette Water Well | \$110,000 | None | The purpose of this water well is to provide effective year-round water for both livestock and wildlife. Benefits may include improved sage grouse habitat. | This project is and off-site project just outside of the PAPO border near Boulder |
| Tyler Ranch Conservation Easement | \$150,000 | \$1,890,150 | This project will help PAPO achieve its primary wildlife goal by maintaining and conserving habitat for species impacted by development in the PAPA | This project is off-site just west of Pinedale |
