Dear Ms. Roadifer,  
 Please consider these comments regarding EnCana's Normally Pressured Lance Project in the Pinedale Anticline and Jonah Fields.

Wild life, not oil and gas should be given greater consideration.

To protect key sage grouse areas and the pronghorn migration corridor from Grand Teton NP to Seedskaadee NWR, I urge the following:  
 Maximum surface density of one wellpad per square mile.

Within sage grouse Core Areas, site wellpads at least 3 miles from sage grouse leks.

Protect a migration corridor at least 2 miles wide where drilling and road construction are prohibited.

Require phased development. Maximum of 25,000 acres under development at any one time. New acreage opened to drilling only after final reclamation of a similar acreage of wellfield.

The BLM should protect the Upper Green River Valley from some of the previous practices that damaged wildlife, public use of the land, water quality, and clean air.
