This letter is in response to your letter we received on December 6, 2007, requesting surface landowner consents for uranium mining activity in T. 25 N., R. 92 W., and T. 25 N., R. 93 W., 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Sweetwater County, Wyoming, our reference WYW-166526.

In accordance with your telephone conversation with Mark Newman, Geologist, on December 6, 2007, we will not sign surface landowner consents until a complete mine and reclamation plan has been submitted to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and they have prepared an environmental document that we have reviewed and concurred with.

In addition, a complete mine and reclamation plan must be submitted to the State of Wyoming, Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), and be deemed complete by the DEQ and us.
