Responsibilities

Project Level: The authorizing agencies (BLM and USDAFS) are responsible for monitoring at the project level; responsibility is frequently extended to the operators.

Basin Level: WGFD maintains sage grouse observation and lek databases, a raptor nest database, and big game seasonal range maps; WGFD shares data with BLM and USDAFS as data is updated. Habitat change and reclamation is responsibility of authorizing agencies (BLM and USDAFS).
